Amendments to the Draft Warrnambool Coastal Management Plan will be considered if the feedback meets the following criteria:

- Relates to the management area identified under section 2.3 and 6.
- Comments that are clear, concise and refer to the page numbers, or section of the plan to which the comment relates.
- Comments which do not support any aspect of the plan and give the reason why, plus provide possible alternative approaches within the scope of the plan.
- Relates to the vision and objective's set out in the plan.
- Identifies issues and/or management strategies relevant to the plan which have not already been identified or are considered a better option that those detailed in the Plan.
- Indicates omissions, inaccuracies or a lack of clarity of existing information.
- Provides an alternative way of expressing an issue and/or management strategy identified in the plan.
